## **REGULAR BOARD MEETING**

May 20, 2019

The Board of Commissioners of the South Walton County Mosquito Control District held its Regular Board Meeting at the District Office at 774 North Highway 393, Santa Rosa Beach, Florida at 9:34 a.m.

The Commissioners attending the meeting were John J.Magee Chairman, Kristine Faulk, and Tim Norris. Staff present: Interim Director Harley Sampson Jr., Office Manager Shirley Steele and Hallie Oalde.

The meeting opened with a Prayer and Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag.

Interim Director Sampson introduced our new Administrative Assistant, Hallie Oalde.

Chairman Magee requested board approval for the month of April 16, 2019 meeting minutes. Commissioner Faulk moved to approve the April 16, 2019 meeting minutes. Commissioner Norris seconded the motion to approve the minutes as presented. The Board unanimously approved.

Financial reports including expenditures for April 2019 presented for approval. Motion was made to approve financial reports with expenditures for April 2019 by Commissioner Norris. Seconded by Commissioner Faulk. The Board unanimously approved.

Building update- DAG is moving forward with plans. Several options/ideas were presented. DAG is currently seeking needs and options desired. Task order#1 included Initial Surveys and Assessments is currently in place. Invoice#18108-0519 for \$7864.00 was submitted for approval. Motion was made to approve DAG Invoice#18108 for \$7864.00 by Commissioner Norris. Seconded by Commissioner Faulk. The Board unanimously approved.

The external investigation was completed by Hand Arendall Harrison Sale LLC outlining the recommendations for the District. A recommendation was to update the employee manuals and policies. Currently new and updated policies and manuals are in progress.

Attorney invoice for Hand Arendall Harrison Sale LLC for \$6445.00 for April and May 2019 was submitted for approval. Motion was made to approve the Attorney services Invoice# 269578 for April 2019 by Commissioner Faulk. Seconded by Commissioner Norris. The Board unanimously approved.

Operations Activity Report for April 2019 the District currently remains in a Mosquito Borne Illness Advisory. For the month of April 2019 we have sprayed 15 routes and completed 62 service request. A Buffalo Turbine mission is scheduled for this week. Mr. Midgett is available to adulticide with the drone at the rate of \$10.00 per acre for the first 20 acres and \$5.00 per acre as needed.

Commissioner Norris discussed the idea of creating a drainage district for South Walton County. A meeting was set with the Walton County attorney to discuss the idea. The Florida Statutes and examples of current Special Districts are included in your packet. Attorney Myers and Amy Tracy are working to establish the guidelines to establish an Improvement District in South Walton County.

A quote for beaver control was presented. The decision was made at this time to outsource beaver problems. The quote for nuisance animal control is for one location. Interim Director Sampson will obtain a contract for services.

Black ball kits are distributed daily.

Semi-annual storm drain almost complete. The ice machine is currently making enough ice for the District and a new ice machine will not be necessary at this time. The District continues to seek delivery of dry ice. Two employees will be attending an in-service for *Glyphosate and alternatives*.

Bimini Bay has a dress cover shirt selected for our uniform this will be worn with jeans and a mosquito control t-shirt. The District will purchase the uniforms and the laundry will be done with a local vendor. The time line for the new uniform will be October 1, 2019.

Dr. John Smith recommended a person for Entomologist/Mosquito Field Technician. Ms. Adams interviewed with Interim Director Sampson and an offer was made pending background and reference checks.

Walton County picked up the dumpsters. Contact was made to discuss the recycling program to return to the District.
